



## PUT YOUR CAR IN THE TIMELINE?

The MG Car Club's Annual Silverstone meeting in June 2014 is a very special one. Named 'MG90' the event celebrates the ninetieth anniversary of the creation of the first MG motor car in 1924.

To mark the anniversary, MG90 will feature a 90-year time line of cars, in which almost every M.G. model will be displayed. The display will take place on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> June and Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> June.

**The Triple-M Register has been invited to contribute cars for inclusion in the display.** We are looking for good original cars - honest representations of the various models. They do not need to be in concours or show car condition.

We are therefore inviting owners to contribute an example of each of the following models:

If you have an example of any of these cars and wish to apply to have it included in the display, here are some things to bear in mind:

- 1. Members of the MG Car Club or other invited Clubs can apply;
- 2. Your car should <u>preferably</u> be available for display on both Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> <u>and</u> Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> June;
- 3. If you cannot manage both dates, please let us know which day your car could be available;
- 4. Please submit details of your car, including a recent photograph, and information about the car's history by e-mailing or posting the form
- 5. The Triple-M Register Committee and the MGCC will be the final arbiters of which models and which cars to include in the display;
- 6. Each selected car will be issued with a rally-type display board incorporating the MG90 signage and its number;
- 7. The partaking members will not only receive the rally board as a memento of the event, but also a certificate. There will also be prizes awarded to the three cars that spectators judge they would most like to take home;
- 8. The intention is to range the cars along the old Copse runway opposite the Register hard-standing areas;
- 9. The display will start by the main MGCC marquee with the oldest cars being nearest to the marquee;
- 10. The event programme will contain full details of those cars on display in numbered order;
- 11. The organisers would wish the cars to be in position no later than 10.00 on both days and for them to remain in place until at least 4.30 pm;
- 12. It is your responsibility to get the display car to and from the event.
